Eruv Tavshilin

Although food preparation such as cooking, baking and lighting a fire (from a pre-existing flame) is permitted on Yom Tov, it is nevertheless Rabbinically forbidden to prepare for another day on Yom Tov. This in theory includes not preparing for Shabbos on Friday which coincides with Yom Tov.

Therefore the "Three Day Yom Tov" poses a problem. How can one prepare three Shabbos meals on Friday (Yom Tov) in advance of Shabbos? To alleviate this problem, the Rabbis instituted a Halachic device called "Eruv Tavshilin-Mingling of Cooked Foods." The rationale is that if preparation for Shabbos begins on Erev Yom Tov, it may continue on Friday without violating the Rabbinic sanction of preparing on Yom Tov for another day. This is done by placing a baked food such as challah or matzah and a cooked food such as fish or meat on a plate and designating them as the Eruv. A special bracha and paragraph is recited (see Artscroll Siddur page 654) declaring one's intention that this device will permit the necessary preparation. The Eruv should not be discarded, but rather incorporated into one of the Shabbos meals to fulfill its purpose. There are many halachos involved in Eruv Tavshilin, however, the above represents the basic information needed to employ the Eruv. Please remember that this Yom Tov season requires Eruv Tavshilin in three times- viz. Erev Rosh Hashana, Erev Succos and Erev Shmini Atzeres.
